



INTERSCHOOL TEAMS SELECTION GUIDELINES

The Interschool Selection Committee agrees that the best athletes should have the opportunity to represent their school.

Athletics

Interschool Teams are selected by a committee of teachers on the basis of:

- Timed race results and at the school carnival
- Attendance at training sessions associated with the carnivals
- A student's ability to demonstrate responsible behaviour and good sportsmanship

Sprints

The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place holders in Division A at the School House Carnival make up the Divisions A, B, C and D in the Interschool Carnival. In the highly unlikely event that the winner of Division B is from the same house as the three placegetters in Division A (ie Division A 1st Klein, 2nd Klein, 3rd Klein, Division B 1st Klein), the committee may consider re-running a time trial.

NB: 3 per faction race in Division A.

Long Distance Running 400m and 800m Races

These events are not timed and the place getters will remain as they stand on the day of the School House Faction event.

Throws and Jumps

Place getters will remain as they stand on the day of the School House Faction event.

Team Games

Years 1 and 2

All schools competing in the Interschool Carnival take the 4 fastest boy and girl runners in Year 1 & 2.
Years 3-6

Teams will be selected based on:

- consistently being deemed best team game members;
- Regular attendance at training; and
- good behaviour, positive attitude, reliability and the will to improve

NB. A student demonstrating the qualities indicated in the last two dot points, will be selected over another close ability student.

Swimming

The Interschool Swimming Team is selected by a committee of teachers on the basis of:

- Recorded times at the Interschool Swimming Trials.

In all circumstances, the interschool selection committee in consultation with the school administration team has the final say in individual and team selections, including whether to consider extenuating circumstances.
