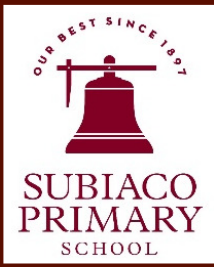

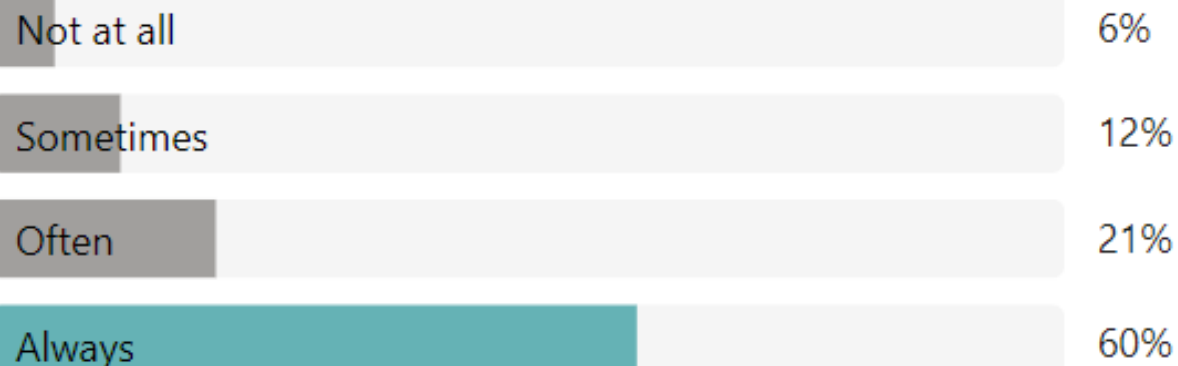
## Digital use

Subiaco Primary School retains a strong focus on developing ethical digital users. We find increasingly, that there is a divide between home use and school use which can cause confusion and mixed messages.

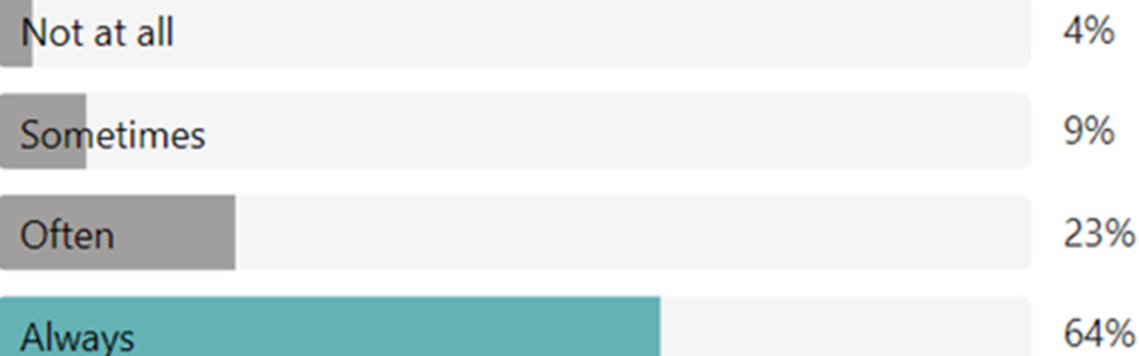

2. I feel comfortable expressing myself online. I make good choices about what I share

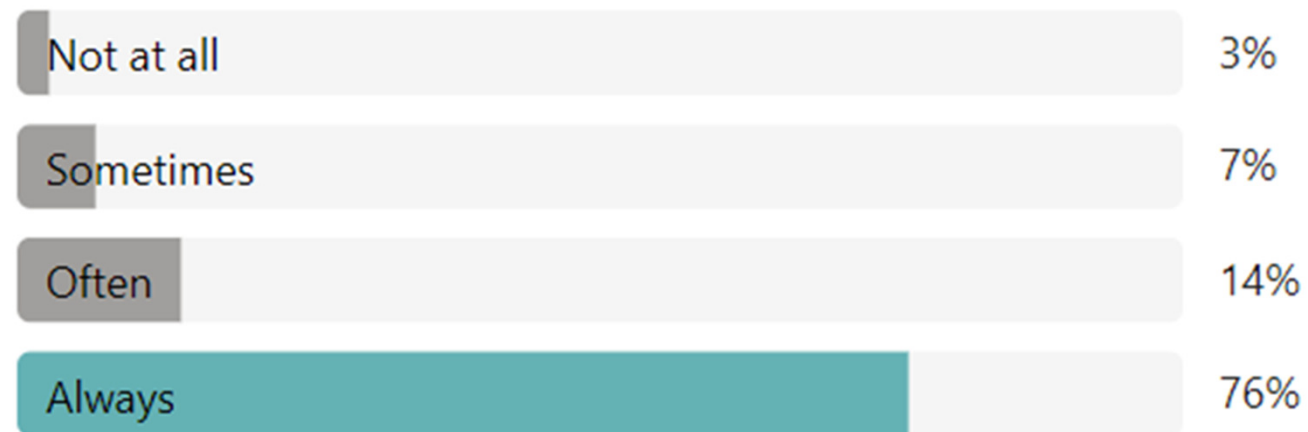


3. I know what to do and who can help if someone is bullying me or one of my friends or...

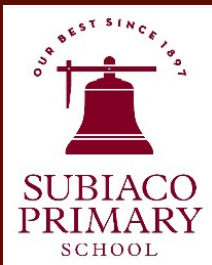

# Digital User Agreement



## SUBIACO PRIMARY SCHOOL DIGITAL USER AGREEMENT – 1 TO 1 iPADS YEARS 4, 5 & 6

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### ***Internet Safety:***

-  My passwords should be kept private and not given out to others.
-  I should only access the internet sites that I have been directed to by my classroom teacher.
-  I will report **anything** that makes me feel unsafe or uncomfortable or if I see others being unsafe using digital technology. I will close my iPad screen immediately and seek advice from my teacher.
-  I will only use text and images from the internet, if I have permission, and I have referenced its source.
-  **I will never** give out my name, phone number, address, name of the school, photographs or other details about myself or others.
-  **I will never** use social media while at school, such as iMessage or Snapchat, including messaging peers or my parents throughout the school day, or my parents messaging me.



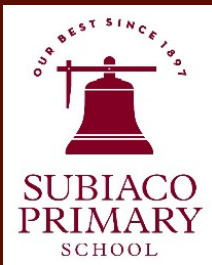
# Digital User Agreement



## ***Caring for my iPad:***

- 👍 Bring your iPad to school fully charged each day.
- 👍 Your iPad should have a strong cover.
- 👍 Your iPad should be carried to and from school in your backpack.
- 👍 Your iPad stays in a locked classroom during the school day.
- 👍 Do not take your iPad out of your backpack while on school grounds (includes Subi After School Care).
- 👍 Never leave your iPad in your backpack at school.
- 👍 Drink bottles should be carried in the outside pocket of school backpack.
- 👍 iPads should be kept in a safe place when not in use.
- 👍 Do not touch another person's iPad without their permission.
- 👍 Keep apps and software regularly updated.
- 👍 All notifications will be turned off during school hours.
- 👍 Air Drop remains off unless otherwise instructed by my teacher.





# Digital User Agreement

## ***Classroom Rules:***

- ☐ I will only use my iPad when my teacher instructs me to do so.
- ☐ I will only take photos and videos when I have been given permission.
- ☐ I will not change any settings (including history) on my iPad.
- ☐ I respect others and will never use digital technology to be mean, rude or unkind.
- ☐ I will follow the *Caring for my iPad* rules.
- ☐ I will follow the *Internet Safety* rules.
- ☐ Only apps from the approved list are to be used at school.

***In order to be a responsible digital citizen I agree to the above conditions, and understand that not abiding by Subiaco's rules may result in me losing iPad privileges.***

## Parental controls on Apple devices

Apple's Content & Privacy Restrictions allow parents to place limitations on the apps and features their child can access on their Apple devices – for instance, restricting your child from accessing explicit content, and preventing them from making purchases and downloads on the device.

# School Support

# Device Requirements

For students to engage fully in the 1:1 iPad classroom we recommend an iPad that:

Is 10th generation minimum to last from year 4-6

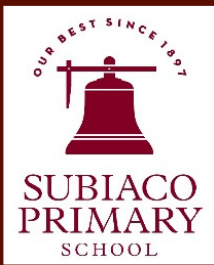
Must have iOS17.1 installed (minimum).  
Ideally have at least 64gb of data storage.

The iPad must come to school with a protective case.  
We prefer an external keyboard – takes up screen space

Headphones are required (plus adaptor).

A Targus slim stylus is a recommended extra.





# Apps List for 2025



**It is essential that the children have all apps, as specified on the app list, already installed on their device.**

Having these apps installed on your child's device will enable them to use their iPad effectively for learning at school.

All apps on the list are tried and tested with an emphasis on educational purpose and creativity.

Some apps come already installed on iPads.

Most are free.

The apps on our lists are our core apps for 2025, however; additional apps may be added to the list throughout the year.
