## INTERSCHOOL TEAM SELECTION POLICY

## POLICY STATEMENT

The Interschool Selection Committee is committed to ensuring that the top-performing athletes are given the opportunity to represent the school. Selections are based on objective performance data, behaviour, and commitment to training, in alignment with school expectations.

## PROCEDURE

### SWIMMING

The Interschool Swimming Team (Years 4–6) is selected by a committee of teachers based on:

- Recorded times and/or video footage from the Faction Swimming Carnival
- Attendance and performance during training sessions.

The results of the Faction Swimming Carnival are considered final. A student/s representing the state or nation in a swimming event will be automatically eligible for selection in the Interschool Swimming Team in that event/s.

No challenges or re-swims will be conducted after the event.

### ATHLETICS

Interschool Athletics Teams (Years 1–6) are selected by a committee of teachers based on the following:

- Performance and placings at the School Faction Athletics Carnival (including timed events where applicable)
- Attendance, effort, and performance at relevant training sessions
- Demonstrated responsible behaviour, positive attitude, and good sportsmanship in line with school expectations.

#### **Sprints, Long Distance 400m & 800m, Throws and Jumps**

- Placegetters in Division A events at the Faction Athletics Carnival will be considered for interschool selection.
- Running events are not timed.

The results of the Faction Athletics Carnival are considered final. A student/s representing the state or nation in an athletics event will be automatically eligible for selection in the Interschool Athletics Team in that event/s.

No challenges or re-swims will be conducted after the event.

#### **Team Games**

Some team games are composed of students who qualified through sprint events, while others are selected based on overall performance, teamwork, positive attitude, regular attendance at training sessions and behaviour demonstrated during training, Faction Carnival and Physical Education lessons.

## CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS & AWARDS

**Swimming:** Championship points and eligibility for Champion Boy/Girl awards are determined solely from results at the Year 4–6 Faction Swimming Carnival. Students must be present on the day to receive points or be eligible for awards.

**Athletics:** Championship points and eligibility for Champion Boy/Girl awards are based solely on results from the Faction Athletics Carnival. Students must be present on these days to receive points or be eligible for awards.

## SUMMARY

Interschool selection considers carnival performance, training participation, and behaviour. A student/s representing the state or nation in an athletics event will be automatically eligible for selection in the Interschool Athletics Team in that event/s.

In exceptional cases, the Interschool Selection Committee and School Executive may take additional factors into account when determining individual or team selections.
