1. Overview

I am happy to give a brief overview of 2022 in the Uniform Shop.

The year was productive and without any major problems in regard to stock deliveries. Some delays were experienced and only one box of stock was 'lost in transit' and that has been replaced by the supplier in the event it is not found. Australia Post is problematic so I have asked major suppliers to send stock by Toll IPEC.

Sales of Uniforms in store and online have been without any problems encountered. The sale of Pool Memberships and Ten Pool Passes in Term 4 were popular. Caro's great assistance ensured this was easy.

The Kindy / Pre Primary Orientation held in Term 4 of '22 over two mornings were well patronised and parents took advantage of shopping directly after the sessions. I have also found that new parents are keen to shop online and collect their purchases before end of term.

2022 was an enjoyable year in the Uniform Shop and I'm confident 2023 should be similar unless there is another Covid outbreak!

Winter Stock orders are being placed now in time for Term 2 demand.

This year Miss Gemma Hayley has offered for her class M4 to assist with uniform deliveries and some easy jobs, folding and packing many gold polos is one of them! I'm very happy to have this help and notice the students really enjoy the opportunity.

Forward planning for 2023. The following is a list of items to be considered.

- Price increases of selected uniforms in line with price increases from Suppliers
- Introduction of a new Sports Faction Polo.
- Choir Polo to be made available for new Junior Choir members to purchase. (*Initial enquiry undertaken as requested by Mr Angel*)
- Upgrade the fixtures in the Uniform Shop. After discussion with Vince the fixtures we have in storage may not be suitable as he felt the shelves may have warped. I really would like this to be a priority please.
