### Overview

#### 1.Close of Season Update:

- Another successful pool season which has now ended, with last session being Sunday 17th March
- Very little downtime with pool operations this year, only one delay in opening one afternoon, otherwise the pool was available for every advertised opening session.
- RLSWA were fantastic yet again, multiple compliments were received from the community on the lifeguards professionalism and efforts which were passed onto their manager (Alison Harding)

#### 2.Upcoming:

- Pool cleanup of lost items and equipment to occur
- Paving around a drain on the southern side will need to be fixed as it presents a trip hazard
- RLSWA advised the water testing kit will need to be replaced. Cost to be confirmed.

### City of Subiaco Update

- Fiona Plant and I met with the COS to discuss partnering again for the 2024/25 season
- The COS suggested there is potentially generous funding arrangements available for partner groups which fit the city's criteria
- We discussed the potential for the COS to fund the installation of a disabled hoist into the pool. the COS advised this could potentially fit their criteria for funding as it provides a minority or disadvantaged group access to the pool
- Potential for COS to provide 'scholarships' for pool memberships to disadvantaged families
- Potential for sponsoring the Splash Down party amongst other sponsorship opportunities or other infrastructure requirements (pool cleaner)
- Investigated the possibility for a point-of-sale ticketing system for pool entry for the next season. This would allow for live data analytics on pool usage allowing for optimising pool opening times
- Upcoming deliverables for COS:
  - o Submission for 2024/25 partnership due end of April
  - o 2023/24 season acquittal due end of August
